

**INCIDENT:** Mountain Home man arrested for internet enticement

**WHEN:** Wednesday, January 13, 2010 at about 6:00pm

**PEOPLE INVOLVED:** Jeffrey Arnold Rathsack, 41, Mountain Home

**DETAILS:** Ada County Sheriff's detectives arrested a Mountain Home man who used the internet to entice a teenager to meet him for sex.

On Wednesday January 13, Jeffrey Arnold Rathsack, 41, of Mountain Home, talked online with a detective who was posing as a teenage girl. Rathsack spoke about his intent to have sexual contact with the girl and arranged to meet her a public location.

At about 6:00 pm, Rathsack arrived at the location. Detectives immediately took the 41-year-old into custody. Rathsack was booked into the Ada County Jail on a charge of Enticing of Children over the Internet. He is scheduled to be arraigned on the charge this afternoon in district court.

This arrest is the result of work by the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force. The Ada County Sheriff's Office receives ICAC grant money to help fund these investigations that are conducted on an ongoing basis.
