INCIDENT: Boise man arrested for internet enticement

WHEN: Friday October 2, 2009

PERSON INVOLVED: Kelly Roy Doms, 32, Boise

DETAILS: Ada County Sheriff's detectives have arrested a Boise man who used the internet to entice a teenager to meet him for sex.

On Friday October 2, Kelly Roy Doms, 32, of Boise, talked online with a detective who was posing as a teenage girl. Doms spoke about his intent to have sexual contact with the girl and arranged to meet her at a public place. Shortly after Doms arrived at the location he was taken into custody. Doms was booked into the Ada County Jail on a charge of sexual enticement of a minor over the internet. He remains in custody awaiting arraignment.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This arrest is a result of work by the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force. The Ada County Sheriff's Office receives ICAC grant money to help fund these investigations that are conducted on an ongoing basis.
